Doncaster Talks 2021 – Doncaster Delivery Together Survey Results


During summer 2021 we held a further Doncaster Talks engagement consultation dedicated to Doncaster Delivering Together, which invited residents to answer three short questions on the wellbeing goals and priorities developed based on all of the previous consultation insights outlined above. Residents were asked to what extent they agreed or disagreed with the wellbeing goals and the affiliated priorities. This survey gained good coverage with a total of 1312 responses, being open for three weeks ending 08.08.2021.

Residents were asked three questions:

- 1. To what extent do you agree or disagree that each of these goals for the future will help to ensure Doncaster will be thriving in ten years' time?
- 2. To help achieve our goals, we are proposing some 'Priorities the Great 8'. These are the big actions we commit to deliver over the next ten years. To what extent do you agree or disagree that these are the right priorities to be making to Doncaster residents?
- 3. Please rank the priorities in terms of their importance. The feedback from the engagement is summarised below.




To what extent do you agree or disagree that each of these goals for the future will help to ensure Doncaster will be thriving in ten years' time?


In terms of follow up comments; the themes that were mentioned the most were:

- Improve safety and reduce crime (including ASB, drugs, rough sleeping)
- Improve highways (roads, pathways, remove pot holes)
- Invest in street cleansing; reduce fly-tipping, litter & dog fouling
- Better access for disabled people; particularly those using public transport
- More respect for local area with improved public spaces
- Look to fill empty shops; reduced business rates for business start-ups.

To what extent do you agree or disagree that each of these goals for the future will help to ensure Doncaster will be thriving in ten years' time?




The top three goals that residents in the East area most strongly agreed with were:


East locality follow-up comments centred on the following themes:

- More investment away from Town Centre

To what extent do you agree or disagree that each of these goals for the future will help to ensure Doncaster will be thriving in ten years' time?




The top goals that residents in the North locality most strongly agreed with were:



South


